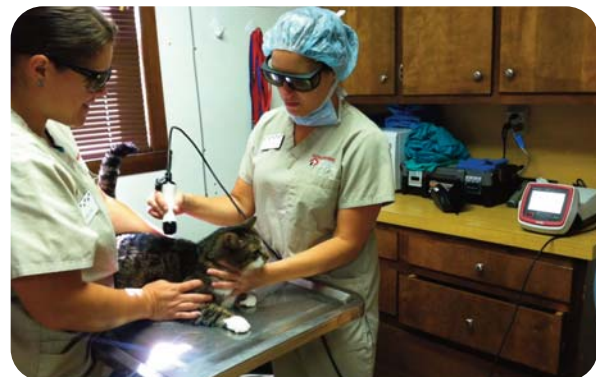
PUPPY U Introducing Puppy University!

Laser Therapy

Cleveland Road Animal Hospital is proud to introduce the addition of healing laser therapy! Laser therapy is a sterile, pain-free, surgery-free, drug-free treatment which is used to treat a variety of ailments, including injuries, wounds, fractures, neurological conditions, numerous dermatological problems and pain. Whether your pet is rehabilitating from trauma or injury, healing from wounds or simply aging, your companion will benefit from this revolutionary new approach to veterinary medicine.



Laser therapy is the only course of treatment that actually stimulates the body to heal from within. Non-thermal photons of light are administered to the body and absorbed by the injured cells. The cells are then stimulated and respond with a higher rate of metabolism. This results in increased circulation from the body, an anti-inflammatory reaction, relief from pain and an acceleration of the healing process.

Numerous CRAH patients have already benefitted from this new treatment after having surgery or to improve more chronic conditions such as arthritis.

Stem Cell Therapy

Cleveland Road Animal Hospital is proud to now offer Stem Cell Therapy! CRAH is proud to be one of the first animal hospitals in the area to offer stem cell therapy as an option for treating patients with canine osteoarthritis of the hip, elbow, knee, shoulder, canine immune mediated polyarthritis, tendon and ligament injuries, and recent surgical repair of joints or ligaments. In addition, any patient who is not responding well or cannot tolerate pain medication, is not a good surgical candidate due to age or health, or when the pet owner prefers a more natural therapy may benefit from stem cell therapy.

In this procedure, several million of an animal's own adult stem cells are harvested from a small sample of their body fat and then administered directly to a site of injury. This amplifies the body's own healing capacity dramatically which speeds recovery and improves their quality of life.
